POLICY

- 1.01 Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology adheres to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education policy statement on admissions to, retention in, and transfer among colleges and universities in the State system.
- 1.02 Article XIII-A of the Constitution of Oklahoma and Title 70, Section 3206 of the Oklahoma Statutes provide that the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall prescribe standards of education for institutions in the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, including standards for "admission to, retention in, and graduation from State Educational Institutions." In order to carry out these constitutional and statutory responsibilities, the State Regents adopted a policy statement establishing curricular requirements, criteria, and standards for admission to State System institutions, as well as standards for retention in and transfer among institutions by type. Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology admission and retention programs conform to these standards.

PROCEDURES

- 2.01 Requests for exceptions to the above policy should be made in writing to the Director of Enrollment Management.
- 2.02 Approved exceptions are reported to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education on an annual basis.
